THE SECRET SAFARI is a character-driven journey of courage, cunning and suspense. In the early 1980s a company called 'Africa Hinterland' was created by the exiled operatives of the African National Congress. 'Africa Hinterland' took tourists on overland sight-seeing trips which crossed the border into South Africa. Unbeknown to the tourists, under the seats of the truck were secret compartments housing military arms and explosives destined for the frontline of the underground military struggle against the notorious apartheid system. The 'Africa Hinterland' operation made some 40 trips across the treacherous South African border loaded with a tonne of weapons each journey. They were never caught.
